3. SCOPE OF WORK:



1. The subcommittee will supervise the implementation of structural and functional upgrades in secondary healthcare hospitals across the province.
2. Develop and guide rollout strategies for hospital revamp initiatives in line with the reform agenda.
3. Monitor improvements in infrastructure, staffing, and service readiness at SHC facilities.

3. Scope of Work:


1. Establish Level 3 Trauma Centers and introduce mammography services at regional DHQ hospitals to enhance emergency and diagnostic capacity.
2. Set up ten Neonatal Intensive Care Units (NICUs) and newborn nurseries across key DHQ hospitals.
3. Ensure 80% availability of essential medicines and 100% functionality of equipment and infrastructure at all SHC hospitals.
4. Equip all SHC facilities with essential diagnostic and treatment technologies.
5. Transition 54 Category-D hospitals to private management models and outsource 20 additional DHQ and THQ hospitals based on existing PPP models.
6. Resolve operational liabilities at SHC hospitals through renegotiated contracts and improved grievance redressal mechanisms.
7. Ensure continuous and reliable supply of insulin to diabetic patients through the Diabetes Control Program.
